

A dvent Week 1: HOPE



Advent is a season of wonder.

We wait in darkness for the light to be kindled, grow, and spread, and for our HOPE to be renewed. But in this secular world, Advent, the period of preparing for the birth of Christ, has been swept up in the "glitz of the holiday season" a frantic time of OVER, over-spending, over-partying, over-decorating, over-eating, just over-doing!

Jesus was born in simplicity in a borrowed manger. During Advent God calls us to open our eyes, minds, and hearts to the subtle and simple ways He seeks to come into our lives. May we recognize God in the ordinary, a smile from a stranger, a simple meal prepared by a loved one, or a co-worker's "Thank you."

The first Advent candle, the Prophecy Candle, reminds us of the HOPE that the prophets and followers had for a savior. God chose an ordinary, young, poor,

oppressed woman to be the mother of His son. Mary's response to God is to say, "Be it done to me, according to your will." Mary and Joseph prepared for this divine birth. How are you also preparing for Jesus' birth this Advent?
