This ancient tradition occurs all over the world but is not

often seen in the United States. Blessing kits will be equipped with chalk, holy water, and instructions on what to do. Blessings should take place on the Feast of the Epiphany, January 6th.

There will be Blessing of Homes kits in the back of both Churches on this weekend December 29th.



Beginning January 5th at St. Mary's Church for seven consecutive Sundays after the 10:00 am Mass there will be a series called "Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible."

This is a one hour weekly program and includes videos by Jeff Cavins. The study gives a helicopter view, beginning with Adam and Eve, and guides us up to the time of Christ and the Church.
