Each year, the Mission Office of our Archdiocese invites a missionary group to every parish to share about their mission work. This appeal will be next weekend. We will welcome the Foundation for Children in Need (FCN), a lay Catholic organization based in Arlington Heights, IL. FCN serves the poor in the interior villages of India. They provide free medical check-ups and medicine to thousands of needy children. Over the past nine years, FCN has provided free corrective surgeries to more than 2000 children born with cleft lip and cleft palate.
