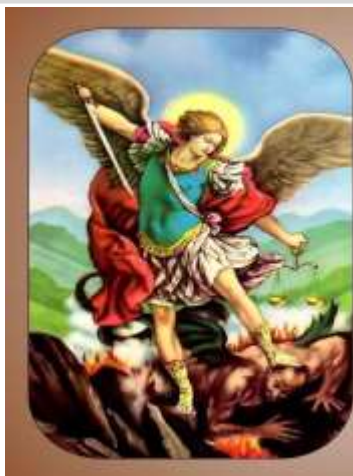

Confession

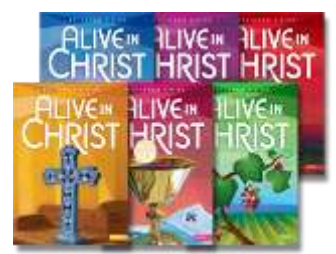
